**CHARLES COUNTY 2011 HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN  
Municipal Adoption Resolution**

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Indian Head, Charles County, Maryland is most vulnerable to natural hazards which may result in loss of life and property, economic hardship, and threats to public health and safety, and

**WHEREAS**, Section 322 of the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (DMA 2000) requires state and local governments to develop and submit for approval to the President a mitigation plan that outlines processes for identifying their respective natural hazards, risks, and vulnerabilities, and

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Indian Head acknowledges the requirements of Section 322 of DMA 2000 to have an approved Hazard Mitigation Plan as a prerequisite to receiving post-disaster Hazard Mitigation Grant Program funds, and

**WHEREAS**, the Charles County 2011 Hazard Mitigation Plan has been developed by the Charles County Emergency Management Agency in cooperation with other county departments, and officials and citizens of the Town of Indian Head, and

**WHEREAS**, a public involvement process consistent with the requirements of DMA 2000 was conducted to develop the Charles County 2011 Hazard Mitigation Plan, and

**WHEREAS**, the Charles County 2011 Hazard Mitigation Plan recommends mitigation activities that will reduce losses to life and property affected by both natural hazards that face the County and its municipal governments.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED** by the Town Council of Indian Head, Maryland, that:


**Section I.** The Charles County 2011 Hazard Mitigation Plan is hereby adopted as the official Hazard Mitigation Plan of the Town of Indian Head, and



**Section IV.** This resolution shall be in full force and effect on the 4th day of June, 2012.


