IN ORDER TO MEET IMPERVIOUS SURFACE REQUIREMENTS, WE ARE REQUIRING THAT THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS BE MET FOR DECKS BUILT IN THE CRITICAL AREA DISTRICT OF INDIAN HEAD;

- 1). THE FLOOR BOARDS MUST BE SPACED AT LEAST 1/4" APART,
- 2). THE GROUND DIRECTLY BENEATH THE DECK MUST HAVE A 6" BED OF GRAVEL (NO PAVING OR PAVERS)
- 3). THE GRAVELED AREA MUST BE RIMMED WITH SHRUBS, BUT CAN ALLOW FOR A WALKWAY SPACE FROM A GROUND LEVEL DOOR.
