The purpose of the Public Hearing is to receive questions and comments from Town residents regarding the revised Critical Area Map.


The Town's Zoning Administrator, Mark Harman provided a summary of the proposed revisions. The amendment was previously approved by the Council, but the Council was required to revisit the proposed changes during a public hearing. The changes were provided by the Critical Area Commission. All future development would have to fall into the constraints of the revised map. The proposed changes have been previously approved by both the Council and the Planning Commission. The purpose of the hearing is to allow for public comment.

Mayor Paulin made a motion to open the floor to public comment. Councilman Albright seconds the motion. All in favor. The floor was opened to public comment.
