SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF INDIAN HEAD, that Section 25-701.1 of Chapter 25, Personnel, Article 7. Employee Benefits, of the Code of the Town of Indian Head (1990 Edition as amended), be and it is hereby repealed and reenacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

CHAPTER 25 – PERSONNEL

1. The following will be observed as paid holidays by all employees of the Town:

New Year's Day	Labor Day
Martin Luther King Day	Veteran's Day
President's Day	Thanksgiving Day
Good Friday	Day after Thanksgiving
Memorial Day	Christmas Day
Juneteenth	INDIGENOUS PEOPLES' DAY
Independence Day	


SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Ordinance shall become

effective (i) at the expiration of twenty (20) calendar days after its approval by the Council.
