SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF INDIAN HEAD, that Section 25-701.1 of Chapter 25, Personnel, Article 7. Employee Benefits, of the Code of the Town of Indian Head (1990 Edition as amended) be and it is hereby repealed and reenacted, with amendments, to read as follows:


1. The following will be observed as paid holidays by all employees of the Town:
