A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING PARTICIPATION IN THE SUSTAINABLE MARYLAND CERTIFIED MUNICIPAL CERTIFICATION PROGRAM

WHEREAS, a sustainable community seeks to optimize quality of life for its residents by ensuring that its environmental, economic and social objectives are mutually supportive; and

WHEREAS, Town of Indian Head strives to save tax dollars, assure clean land, air and water, improve working and living environments as steps to building a sustainable community that will thrive well into the new century; and

WHEREAS, Town of Indian Head hereby acknowledges that the residents of Town of Indian Head desire a stable, sustainable future for themselves and future generations; and

WHEREAS, Town of Indian Head wishes to support a model of government which benefits our residents now and far into the future by exploring and adopting sustainable, economically-sound, local government practices; and

WHEREAS, by endorsing a sustainable path Town of Indian Head is pledging to educate itself and community members further about sustainable activities and to develop initiatives supporting sustainable local government practices; and

WHEREAS, as elected representatives of Town of Indian Head, we have a significant responsibility to provide leadership which will seek community-based sustainable solutions to strengthen our community;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that to focus attention and effort within Town of Indian Head on matters of sustainability, the Town Council wishes to pursue local initiatives and actions that will lead to Sustainable Maryland Certified Municipal Certification.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Town Council of the Town of Indian Head that we do hereby authorize Town Manager Ryan L. Hicks to serve as the Town of Indian Heads agent for the Sustainable Maryland Certified Municipal Certification process and authorize him to complete the Municipal Registration on behalf of Town of Indian Head.


Vision Statement

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this amended resolution shall be in full force and effective on the 5th day of October, 2015.


