

TOWN COUNCIL WORK SESSION MINUTES
Teleconference via GoToMeeting
Wednesday, January 24, 2024
3:30pm

Mayor Paulin and Vice Mayor Sitoula met in work session via teleconference on Wednesday, January 24, 2024. Also, in attendance Town Manager Ryan Hicks, and Town Clerk Andrea Brady.

February Town Meeting Agenda – No changes or additions.

Roundtable:

Mayor – Asked for an update on conversations being held with Amazon representatives, Town Manager Hicks stated his meeting is scheduled for 10am on February 1st.

Vice Mayor – Vice Mayor Sitoula reminded Mayor Paulin to follow up with Bonnie as it relates to her arts program. Vice Mayor Sitoula asked for an update on the benches for the Boardwalk. Town Manager Hicks went over the cost information discussed at the previous work session. Bench dedication would cost \$600 for the interested party and the Town would cover the other half of the cost. Vice Mayor Sitoula asked if someone wanted to pay the full amount if it would be permitted. Town Manager Hicks said yes, that would be allowed. Checks need to be made out to the Town of Indian Head, with Boardwalk Bench in the memo line.

Councilwoman – Not present.

Town Manager – Budget meetings, need to start scheduling those, asked for dates/times that work for the Council. Mentioned the possibility of needing to raise taxes and fees. MP suggested 1 to 2 virtual meetings in February and then once a week until finalized. Damage was done to the Pavilion. We are in the process of finding the footage on the cameras. Town Manager Hicks reviewed the damage done. He intends to prosecute the fullest once the appropriate footage is found.

Town Clerk – Town Clerk Brady reviewed questions from the Charles County Arts Alliance with Council as it relates to the 2024 Artsfest, and reviewed 4th of July details.
