

TOWN COUNCIL WORK SESSION MINUTES

Mayor Paulin and Councilwoman Stillwell met in a work session via teleconference on Wednesday, June 18, 2025. Also, in attendance were Town Manager Hicks and Town Clerk Andrea Brady.

July Town Meeting Agenda – No changes or additions at this time, but there may be a future addition to the agenda.

Roundtable:

Mayor – Held a meeting today with Doug Meeker of Elm Street Development along with Town Manager Hicks and legal counsel, Fred Sussman to review the purchase agreement for the Henderson Property. There will be some amendments to the agreement and the hope is to have the agreement on the agenda for introduction during the July Town meeting.

Vice Mayor – Not present.

Councilwoman – Attended ArtsFest on Saturday and the restroom was taken up by performers getting ready. Councilwoman Stillwell asked if there is a separate place they could get ready. Town Manager Hicks explained that two dressing rooms were made available for their use, but the performers made the choice to get ready in the restroom. Town Manager Hicks will have a discussion with the Charles County Arts Alliance before next year's event.

Town Manager – Will not be attending MML next week. The IRS has requested use of the Pavilion to assist people who may have any IRS-related questions or concerns. They will utilize the facility in September.

Town Clerk – Gave a brief update on the upcoming 4th of July event.

Mayor Paulin discussed the upcoming events and gave kudos to Town staff for coordinating with so many groups to make these events happen.
