

TOWN COUNCIL WORK SESSION MINUTES
Teleconference via GoToMeeting
Wednesday, October 27, 2021
3:30pm

Mayor Paulin and Vice Mayor Sitoula met in work session via teleconference on Wednesday, October 27, 2021. Also, in attendance were Town Manager Ryan Hicks and Town Clerk Andrea Brady.

Draft Legislation: Waiver of Commercial Permit Fees & Council Salary Increase – These Ordinances will be on hold until a new member of Council has been appointed. An ad for applications for Council will be put on the website and in the paper as well as on Town social media accounts.

In Person Meetings – Meetings will remain virtual at this time. This will continue to be a monthly agenda item moving forward.

November Town Meeting Agenda – The Community Affairs section will be removed from the agenda for the time being. Announcement of Council seat will be added under New Business.

Roundtable:

Mayor – Mayor Paulin formally accepted Councilman Albrights resignation. Mayor Paulin made a motion to approve the ad for a new councilperson and accept the resignation of Councilman Albright. Vice Mayor seconds the motion. Motion approved.

Vice Mayor – Vice Mayor Sitoula spoke about the success of the IHVFD food truck event.

Councilman – Not present.

Town Manager – Spoke about a retaining wall installed by a previous owner at 5 Leslie Drive. The new owner feels the Town should help with the repairs since it is holding up the Town's property. Town Manager is in agreement with the property owner, and he will be sending someone out to do repairs to the wall. The Boardwalk's revised completion date is in December. Currently, we do not have a date for a formal opening.

Town Clerk – Town Clerk Brady asked the Council about holiday events. The Council agreed to hold the tree lighting similarly to the way it was held last year and hold additional holiday events next year.

Mayor Paulin adjourned the work session at 3:43pm.
